Performance Returns

The RoboCap UCITS Fund USD Institutional Founder share class ended May with a NAV of 142.15, up +5.69% in May and +24.88% year-to-date.

Investment Objective & Strategy

RoboCap is a thematic equity fund focusing on Robotics and Automation listed stocks. This fast-growing theme includes general automation, industrial robotics, healthcare robotics, 3D printing, drones, autonomous vehicles, key components, enabling software and artificial intelligence. A key aspect of the strategy is that we aim to primarily invest into 'pure-play' stocks which have at least 40% of sales coming from Robotics and Automation related end markets. The portfolio aims to hold 22-30 positions out of a target universe of 170 stocks. The investment selection is based on fundamental proprietary analysis in cooperation with leading robotics experts.

Market Commentary

May was yet another strong month for the fund spurred on by continued confidence in the underlying growth trends for robotics and automation related stocks as well as a further step-change reduction in political risk in Europe in particular. Along with some U.S. and European companies that were still reporting 1Q numbers in the month a number of Japanese companies reported full year results as well as expectations for the upcoming fiscal year. As with their foreign peers, in general the guidance from these companies was very positive with good demand-driven momentum seen for the next 12 to 24 months. These factors helped the fund to achieve its second best monthly performance.

By sub-theme, 3D printing stocks had a strong month as some further clarity was given on 2017 and longer-term growth and margin targets whilst at the same time moves to shed unprofitable business lines and generally cut costs appear to be working. Consumer robotics also has a good month as the market leader, iRobot, made moves to consolidate its technology leadership position by launching patent infringement law-suits against copy-cat technology from Asia. The performance of Autonomous Vehicles related stocks was a slight drag on the portfolio after a very strong run in the prior four months.

From a macro-economic view, leading indicators for manufacturing such as Purchasing Managers Indices (PMI's) and factory orders remain at multi-year highs around the world and further support the current positive outlook. We also expect no significant impact from the U.K. election and the upcoming German election however we will continue to monitor geo-political risks very closely. Given current valuations, we intend to take profits in some positions while initiating new ones in attractively valued companies with strong fundamentals.

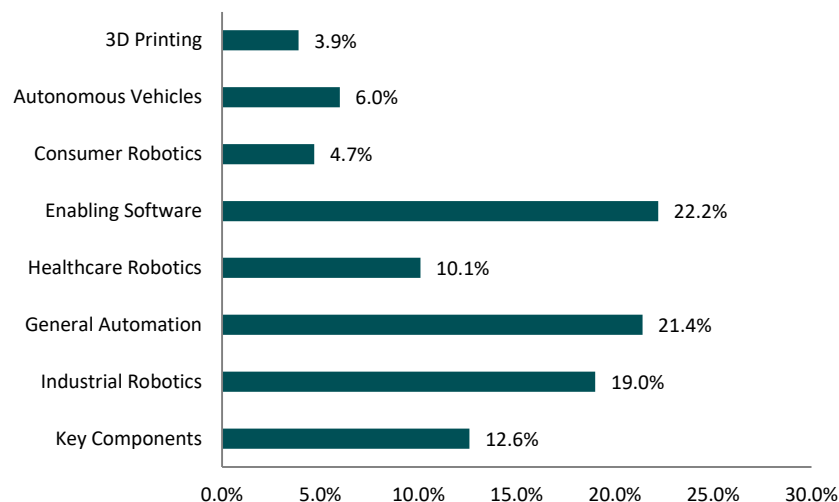
